Dear PARENTS, TEACHERS, STUDENTS, and Building Occupants.

In 1986, Congress passed the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) requiring schools to inspect and identify any asbestos-containing materials (ACBM). The La Veta School District hired a certified building inspector (Advantage) Environmental/Safety Resources, llc to identify and sample any suspect asbestos-containing building materials.

The law further requires the school to have an asbestos management plan. The La Veta School District has an asbestos management plan available in the school maintenance building and the High school office during regular business hours. Mike Zanolini is our designated asbestos program coordinator , and all inquiries regarding the asbestos plan and all asbestos –related issues should be directed to Mike Zanolini at 719-742-3662 ext. 22

Updates as of 3/07/ 2017:

On 11 / 13/ 2015 a representative of Advantage Environmental / Safety Resources, Donna Elsom, conducted a three AHERA re- inspection of our districts facilities, as required by the federal Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) and Colorado Regulation No. 8. A copy of that report are available during regular business hours. The school maintenance staff inspected the condition of the suspect materials every six months and all is good. This summer the district will hire Advantage to come down and inspect the Junior High and Gym to have it cleared of suspect asbestos materials. Then the High School and Annex buildings the next summer of 2018. As of to date the Elementary and the Vo Agg buildings have been tested and cleared or asbestos materials. The Goal of the district is to have all buildings tested and cleared by the summer of 2018.
